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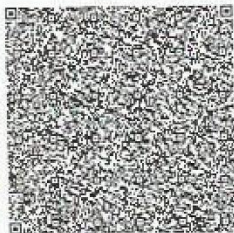

TRUST DEED

ALL INDIA INSTITUTE OF TRAINING AND EDUCATION

This Deed of Trust of "All India Institute of Training and Education" is declared on this 21TH Day of October, 2013. In order to fulfill the mission and vision of Father Mr. Rambali & Mother Mrs. Shobhavati Devi , by "Mr. DILIP KUMAR S/O Rambali , R/o Village- Firojpur, Post-Bishunpur, Pargana- Anguli, Tahsil- Shahganj, District-Jaunpur, Utter Pradesh INDIA, hereinafter called the 'SETTLER'/ Founder of this above said Trust.

WHEREAS THE SETTLER is the absolute owner of a sum Rs. 1,000 (Rupees One Thousand Only) and he is desirous of settling of the said sum of rupees 1,000 (Rupees One Thousand Only) upon public and charitable and Educational Purpose, subject to the provision hereby declared and concerning. Trust will operate across India.

AND WHEREAS the TRUSTEES shall be:

Called the TRUSTEES which expression shall include them, the survivors of them and the executors and administrators of the last survivor or the Trustees for the time being of the Trust created hereby

NOW THIS TRUST DEED WITNESS ES AS FOLLOWS:

The name of the Trust shall be: "All India Institute of Training and Education" That the registered office of the Trust shall be situated at: "House No. 68, 69 Second Floor, Nehru Vihar, New Delhi - 110054" India.

1. The Board of Trustees shall hold a sum of Rupees 1,000.00 (Rupees One Thousand Only), this day paid to them and all monies, funds, other movable or immovable properties and incomes thereof which may hereinafter be received by the Board of Trustees from time to time as Gifts, Donations, Grants,

Subscriptions or otherwise for the purposes of the Trust and the Trust fund shall vest in the Trustees jointly.

2. That the objectives of the Trust shall be wholly for the public and charitable purposes and incomes shall be applied for the same and accumulated in India wholly for public & charitable purposes without prejudice to generality of provisions aforesaid and the following shall be deemed to be the principal objectives of "All India Institute of Training and Education"

TRUST DEED:-

The amount contributed by the founder/settler & Trustees shall and will stand possessed the same upon the trust and also the trustees may from time to time receive for augmenting the trust funds as donations, gifts, interests to capital deposit amount of Rs.1000/-(Rupees one thousand only)etc. for the General public and General Purpose of the trust fund of the trust arising from the subscriptions, donations, grants, or otherwise from any sources and also of any investment etc. representing the same, (HEREINAFTER CALLED 'THE TRUSTEE')

Further-more the net income from the said trust fund, to apply both the capital and income of the said trust fund for the purpose and betterment of the aims and objects only of the said trust.

TRUST PROPERTIES:

The Trustees shall stand and possessed of the said amount of corpus and such other properties, both moveable and immovable as may be acquired from time to time by the Trust, viz. by purchase, exchange, grants subscriptions, or the endowment donations gifts, contribution or in any manner whatsoever all of which shall be designated 'THE TRUST PROPERTIES' of the Trust herein mentioned above.

EXECUTIVE BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

That all the trustees of the said trust shall be called 'THE EXECUTIVE BOARD OF TRUSTEES' LIFE MEMBER".

The above mentioned three trustees of the said trust shall be called 'THE LIFE MEMBER TRUSTEE'.

FOUNDER MEMBERS:

The above said settler/chairman/founder of this Trust and all the said Trustees i.e., shall be called 'THE FOUNDER OF THE SAID TRUST'

THE MANAGING TRUSTEE:

The Founder Trustees – Mr. DILIP KUMAR shall be the permanent Managing Trustee of the said trust till his lifetime. After Mr. DILIP KUMAR his sons is the remaining trustees for the time being shall elect one of themselves as the Managing Trustee. It shall, however be opened that the Managing Trustees shall be elected by 2/3rd majority of the said Board of Trustee of the said Trust, in the General Meeting of the Board.

WHO MAY BE APPOINTED AS TRUSTEE

Dilip Kumar

Any person may be appointed as Trustee or trustees of the said Trust appointed by the majority of 2/3rd of the present Trustees and with the consent of the Settler/Founder/Chairman.

THE MINUTES BOOK:-

It shall be kept by the managing trustee Minutes Book is an office book in which the presence of every trustee and all proceedings of the meeting of the Board of trustees shall be recorded in the minutes book and shall be signed by Chairman of the meeting either at the conclusion thereof or at the next meeting when it they shall be confirmed.

BANK ACCOUNT:-

The Trustees shall have to deposit the trust money or any portion thereof in any nationalized Bank, such accounts can be operated by the signatures of Chairman/Managing Trustee who holds the office of Cashier/Treasurer of the said trust.

To open any type of bank account (s) weather saving account, current account, fixed or otherwise, in the name of the Trust or institution (s) or programmed (s) rub by the Trust with any scheduled banks (s) or post office (s) and to operate by the authorized signatory

BOOK OF ACCOUNT:-

Proper and regular account of all accounts, receipts and expenditure of the said trust shall be maintained regularly.

AUDIT:-

On 31st day of March of every year General Account shall be taken of all the assets and liabilities of the trust and an income & expenditure account for the whole year and a balance sheet as on 31st day of March shall be passed by the trustees the accounts of the trust shall be audited annually by a chartered Accountant appointed by the Trustees for the purpose.

DISSOLUTION OF THE TRUST:-

That the above said Trust shall be dissolved at any time by Settler/Founder but no profit shall be used by any trustee or settler of the said Trust. The Trust fund, properties either moveable and immoveable shall be spent only for the welfare of the poor and General public or to other Trust/society having the similar aims and objects. This Trust shall be IRREVOCABLE for all time after death of Founder/Settler.

JURISDICTION OF THE COURT:-

Only the competent courts of Jaunpur Utter Pradesh INDIA shall entertain all the legal proceedings, cases and suits related to the said Trust.

THE AIMS AND OBJECTS OF THE SAID TRUST:

1. To promote welfare, social cultural, charitable, health education, humanitarian, and relief activities that will protect, safeguard, improve the quality and raise the standard of human life, particularly

- economically weaker sections of the society, irrespective of caste creed, race colour, sex or religion so that they may lead healthy, happy contented and dignified life.
2. To help and collaborate in establishing and running medical centers, old age homes, Ashrams, rehabilitation, institutions for the destitute, vocational training centers, for the handicapped and self job-oriented activities for the unemployed.
 3. To offer scholarships, stipends and financial support to deserving students in pursuing higher studies in medicine Art, science, Engineering and computer technology.
 4. To promote and established study center all over India of Teachers Training Courses, Vocational Courses, Computer Courses, Hardware & Networking Courses.
 5. To undertake and support any program or projects that provide educational, recreational, social cultural and spiritual activities with the sole purpose of promoting peace, love, tolerance and national integration among the various communities of the country and Nationalities of the world.
 6. Sponsorship of economically weak persons for institutional care.
 7. Collaboration with other voluntary organizations to accomplish the above objects.
 8. Affiliation with other national and international organizations engaged in welfare, health education, National integration, and peace-promotion activities.
 9. Regular dialogue and rapport with central, State Government and N.G.O's to elicit support and cooperation in fulfilling the aims and objects of the organization (Charitable Trust).
 10. To acquire immovable and moveable properties by purchase lease, mortgage, gifts, grants, legacy, bequest, exchange, right privilege from any person/s, company, society, Government corporative bodies or institutions whatsoever and to hold moveable and immovable properties lawfully held of all descriptions.
 11. To erect/build residential complexes, hostels, hospitals and any other type of building or structures whatsoever, to further any objects of the Charitable Trust and to maintain, manage, control, improve, alter, repairs, demolish or reconstruct the same or any portion or portions thereof.
 12. To receive by way of gift, whether in cash money or property moveable or immovable, donations and contributions in any legal form, including legacy, bequest, wills, trusteeship, etc, for the benefit of the Charitable Trust.
 13. To alienate by way of sale, mortgage, lease, charge transfer all or any part of the property of the charitable Trust.
 14. To invest and re-invest any funds or moneys of the Charitable Trust in the interest of the beneficiaries of the Trust.
 15. To execute such agreements, conveyances, transfers, leases license, mortgages, documents, etc. as may be deemed necessary to carry out the objects of the Charitable Trust.
 16. To borrow and or raise any funds with or without security in any manner the charitable trust may think to repay the same.
 17. To negotiate with or enter into arrangements with different authorities, bodies, industrial houses for grants, allowances, rights, concessions, and privileges, etc. that may be beneficial to the charitable trust beneficiaries.
 18. To use all the income from the properties moveable or immovable or from the earning of the Charitable Trust as such whosoever derived from, solely for the advancement of the objects. And that no portion of it be distributed or disbursed among the Trustees by way of profits, bonuses or dividends. However nothing herein contained shall prevent the payment in good faith in the shape of remuneration or reimbursement to any Trustee for any services rendered to the charitable trust or expenses incurred thereto.
 19. To appoint or to remove staff of different grades, prescribe their duties, assignments, service conditions and to fix their wages, remunerations and perquisites, etc.
 20. The income and earnings of the charitable trust shall be utilized to attain the aims and objects of the organization as desired by the Trustees of Charitable Trust.
 21. To undertake and promote human resources in the field of social work and in other science relating to social action for world peace.

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22. To undertake and maintain and assist any relief measures in those parts which become subjected to natural calamities such as flood, fire, drought famine, cyclone, earth-quake epidemics, storm, accidents, pestilence, etc.
23. To provide a common platform for social, educational, economic, political, legal and environmental advancement of people in need.
24. To establish, maintain and Manage Colleges, Professional colleges, Schools and Technical and non technical Institutions of all kinds with hostel and/or boarding facility including Research Institutions for good education and advancement of knowledge to poor and unaffordable people with special emphasis to poor Women's & children's education.
25. To profess and undertake sustainable Agriculture development activities involving Organic farming methods and specially help small and marginal farmers.
26. To initiate and promote family welfare, adult literacy, non formal education, general awareness education specifically on health and hygiene, environmental sanitation, reproductive and child health etc.
27. To assist women and men to form Self help groups with savings and credit activities and to promote rural banking in villages.
28. To establish and run care homes/boarding homes for orphan children, aged people, widows, destitute and deserted women and children.
29. To undertake and promote rural community health programs in deserving villages.
30. To develop, defend public justice and solve problems of the oppressed and to safeguard and protect the Fundamental rights guaranteed to all Indian citizens in the Constitution of India.
31. To print and publish books, pamphlets, leaflets, magazines, periodicals, journals etc. on the activities, development and other common issues pertaining the objects of the Trust and distribute them free or at cost to public.
32. To promote National Integration, Communal Harmony, Universal Brotherhood Global Peace and fight against HIV/AIDS and other communicable diseases.
33. To establish an award for the deserving people in the field of Music, Art grass root level social service, communal harmony, brotherhood and peace.
34. To work for Environmental Protection, Forestation, Plantation, Waste Land Management and promote cottage industries, *Khadi*, and traditional handicraft.
35. To run/ operate different types of education program/schools like formal, non-formal, pre-school for the education development of under privileged children of the community/trust.
36. To work against the exploitation of Animals & Birds and make sincere efforts to protect them.
37. To save or protect National Heritage, Buildings or Places of the archeological & historic importance.
38. To establish Citizen Forum (s) and Resident Welfare Association (s) for the development of high values of the Unity, Brotherhood, Communal Harmony and Peace.
39. To Raise voice against all kind of human rights violations nationally and internationally through various different means.
40. To promote and advocate Human Rights and Fundamental Freedom for all without any discrimination of race, religion, caste, color, sex and language.
41. To build Educational portfolios like universities /management colleges/engineering/ architecture /pharmacy / Technical and Medical Colleges etc..
42. To organize and take up Health, Educational and Welfare programmes for needy Women and children on priority basis.
43. To Protect and preserve Wildlife and live stocks as well as animal rights and work for Rain water harvesting and agriculture development as well as farmers rights.
44. To provide the Fellowship and scholarship in the field of education.
45. To promotes National Integration, Science Education & Research, Communal Harmony, Universal Brotherhood and Global Peace.
46. To establish book bank (library) for the underprivileged & Needy Students.

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47. To develop and mobilize Community and Natural Resources to give the right direction to people of the marginalized and economically weaker section of the Society by the Trust for their sustainable overall development.
48. To work with special concentration for the Child & Women Welfare.
49. To conduct research studies on the social & economic conditions of people with a view to involving ways and means for their development within their social historical frame works and to seek promotion of rural development such as provision of drinking water rural industrialization as well as Public Convenience for people.
50. To explore ways for promotion of socio economic development in the community.
51. To undertake, organize, conduct and facilitate, Courses, conferences, lectures, research and education on various aspects and of science, technology, trust and other fields.
52. To train the downtrodden people in general for human resource development in view of the emerging needs such as database development, resource survey methodologies, computer, environmental, studies, health, education, and energy problems.
53. To undertake and promote the publication & translation of journal, research papers and books and to develop the audiovisual programmed to disseminate knowledge pertaining to the objectives of the trust.
54. To work for the welfare of the Society for neglected and underprivileged people and protest and fight against the injustice against people.
55. To aid or establish any institution technical or otherwise, to promote education of arts, Science or other related fields for the benefit of downtrodden and weaker sections of the Society.
56. To arrange and provide medical aid and other assistance necessary for living to the needy people who are incapable or handicapped or mentally/physically retarded and financially unfit.
57. To start and assist the relief measures in those parts of the country which become effected to natural calamities like famine, fire, flood, earthquakes etc.
58. To communicate and coordinate with the Govt. Local and public authorities on various issues related to development welfare and public interest on different subjects.
59. To construct, maintain, alter, improve or develop any building belonging to the trust or works necessary or convenient for the purpose of the Society.
60. To arrange / establish and maintain centers of adult education, vocational education, technical training, low cost education, formal & non-formal education.
61. To aware people about various social issues to fight against evils.
62. To fight against Dowry system and to take necessary steps to provide help to suffering women.
63. To issue appeals raise funds and accept gifts, donation subscriptions in cash or in kind and any property either movable or immovable for the achievement of the objective of the trust.
64. To acquire, purchase or otherwise own or under take on loan or lease or hire temporarily or permanently and movable or immovable property necessary or convenient for the furtherance of the objects of the trust.
65. To organize and take-up Health, Educational and Welfare programmers for needy & poor Women & Children.
66. To promote and protect Indian Traditional music, dance, handicraft, handlooms, Art, modern art & literature.
67. To support the families and relatives of artists for promoting the budding artists in the Society.
68. To establish an award for the deserving people in the field of Music, Arts grass root level social service, communal harmony, brotherhood and peace..
69. To establish residential and non-residential cultural centers for promoting Music, Dance and other Arts. To work for Environmental Protection, Forestation, Plantation, Waste Land Management.
70. To organize vocational training for women and needy people. Organize awareness camps, health camps, March, workshops, campaign and exhibition.
71. To provide various medical services such as organizing health and awareness camps of Immunization, Eye Care, Motherhood, Child Care, and Communicable Diseases.

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72. To prevent any epidemics and to advocate both permanent and temporary measures of Family Planning.
73. To provide basic medical facility, sanitation, general health care and other needful support which can be helpful for public to overcome sufferings and agony of any natural and manmade disaster and to facilitate them to rehabilitate.
74. To provide medical, emotional, psychological, social and medical support to senior citizens of our trust by setting up various drop-in centers, senior citizen homes, old-age homes and other entertainment centers so that these highly honorable people should not be neglected.
75. To undertake activities for sensitizing people to preserve the natural resources of our nation and to maintain the ecological balance of the area.
76. To provide and facilitate legal assistance to underprivileged and poor section of Society to fight for their rights and justice.
77. Trust will run medical colleges/schools/Institutes to provide the diploma/certificate in medical courses.
78. To help poor, widows, handicapped, orphans, old aged, mentally retired and under privileged section of the community.
79. To run/ operate different types of educational programmes/schools like formal, non-formal, pre-school for the educational development of under privileged children of the community.
80. To run the different types of health programmes to raise the health status of vulnerable groups, poor and needy.
81. To make up efforts for the education, welfare and development of women, children, SC/ST , minority and backward community in both urban and rural areas throughout the country.
82. To establish the medical facilities in the working locality (if required) such as family planning centers, dispensaries, hospitals etc.
83. To run and open the schools for the welfare and upliftment of the needy children and also to run adult education programmes.
84. To publish books, magazines, charts, issue related IEC (Information, Education and Communication) materials and other periodical illustration for generating the income for the trust for the benefit of its aims.
85. To open / run / manage institute / college of higher / professional / vocational education in any part of the country for providing quality education and training to youth and children.
86. To open the schools and Institutes for physically challenged disabled children's.
87. To promote and protect natural herbs and plants by cultivation, preservation, storage, processing, demonstration, creating botanical garden and providing necessary training.
88. To establish / run / manage hospitals, health centers, mobile health clinics, research centre to provide health care, counseling and referral services for all kinds of illness and deceases.
89. To promote traditional therapies like Yoga, Naturopathy, Meditation, Acupressure, Acupuncture, Massage Therapy, Ayurveda, Homeopathy, Reiki etc.
90. To establish, build or manage Hostels, Short Stay Homes, Rehabilitation Centers, Shelters, Crèches, Child Care Centre or Children's Home, Counseling Centers and Help Line Centers for Women, Children, Old aged persons, Drug addicts and needy persons.
91. To work for the welfare of Agricultural workers, Farmers, Unorganized Labours, Industrial Labours and Migrated Labours.
92. To form women groups, youth groups, self help groups; old aged groups, adolescent groups, children groups/clubs, community leaders groups and group of volunteers.
93. To work for welfare & support for the families of Martyrs and Prisoners. Work against the exploitation of Animals & Birds and make sincere efforts to protect them.
94. To celebrate annual day of the trust every year as cultural & social event.
95. To Promote and support voluntary donation of Blood, Eyes and other parts of human body for the charitable purpose.
96. To save or protect National Heritage, Buildings or Places of the archeological & historic importance.
97. To organize event management programmes in the field of music and films.

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98. To spread the teachings & thoughts of great leaders, philosophers, thinkers, reformers and saints.

"POWERS, FUNCTIONS, RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF" 'THE TRUSTEES OF THE SAID TRUST'

The powers, functions, rights and duties of the above said trustees shall be as under:-

1. Without effecting the generality of powers and duties and functions of the trustees to manage and administer the trust, The Board of Trustees shall have the following functions:-
 - i) To borrow if needed be against the security or the assets of the trust by way or bank over drafts loan or otherwise, as may be necessary, for the benefits of the trusts provided, however, the trustees unanimously agreed on such borrowing and limits to the terms of this decision or agreement and or authorize two or more of the trustees to execute such documents, deed, papers., etc. and as may be necessary in connection the Trust.
 - ii) To arrange for and/or authorize the signing or execution of any agreement, contract, installment, document or any other paper in writing require to be signed or executed on behalf of the trustees by any two of the trustees to be nominated in this behalf by the Board of Trustees & with the consent of the settler and to make the same effective and binding as if the agreement of contracts instrument or documents or papers or writing were signed by all the trustees.
 - iii) To appoint or make provision for the appointment of a sub Committee of Trustees and/or others to attend or to supervise or conduct specified jobs or functions of the trust matters in such manners and subject to such Rules and Regulations as The Trustees may prescribed.
 - iv) To authorize any one or more Trustees to hold any property or any fund or any investment of the Trust subject, however, to the terms of these presents in such manners and subject to such terms and conditions, Rules and Regulations as the Board of Trustees may from time to time make as they think fit and proper.
 - v) To spend any portion of the corpus fund or the income of the trust for purchasing any land or construction any or building for the Trust.
2. Trustees shall have full powers to determine the programs of the Trust by organizing, suggesting, or by adopting or rejecting the proposals from the public and may delegate any of the powers of professionals or administrative staff whose reports of and activities shall be arranged to be received periodically to control and to give guidance in this regard thereto.
3. The Managing Trustee shall have powers from time to time to make and alter or amend the Rules and Regulations if needed so made this regard of which any power or duty is vested in them, as they may think fit and proper.
4. The Trustee may appoint advocates, secretaries, Engineers, Surveyors, or other employees for the purpose of management and supervision of the Trust estate, funds for collection of rents, effects and profits, for keeping the account and records and for other purposes of the Trustee.
5. The Trustees shall have full power to compromise or compound all actions, suits, and other proceedings and settle difference and disputes touching the trust estate(s) and /or the trust properties and to refer any such differences, disputes to arbitration and to adjust and settle all accounts relating to the trust estate and/or the trust properties and to do all other acts and things fully and effectually without being liable or answerable for any bonafide losses occasioned thereby.
6. The veto of the majority of the members shall prevail and in the event of tie, the chairman of the meeting shall have the power of casting of his/her vote.

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7. Any Resolution passed by the 2/3rd majority of the present trustees, with the consent of the settler/Founder/Chairman for the benefits and the same shall be prevail and applicable to the members.
8. A person shall cease to be trustee, in case, if he/she dies or if becomes bankrupts or becomes in same or otherwise incapable to act or if any trustee or trustees resigns from his/her/their, or removed by the Board of Trustees with the consent of the said settler, by 2/3rd majority, shall be removed from his/her office.
9. If any one or more of the objects specified herein these presents are held not to be objects of a public charitable nature the trustees shall not carry out such objects or object as if the same are not incorporated in these present but the validity of the trust created by these presents as a trust shall not be affected in any manner.
10. The Managing Trustee has to carry on the objects with co - operation of the Trustees.
11. Every property of the Trust, movables or immovable to be acquired in future shall be kept in the name of the Trust.
12. The tenure of the Founder Trustee – Author/ Settler of the Trust **Mr. DILIP KUMAR** is the permanent Chairman /Managing Trustee of the Trust till his lifetime. The Trust shall be entitled to frame rules and regulations for the conduct of its business, the administration of the Trust, carrying out its objectives and facilities provided therein and to alter, amend or any such rules and regulations from time to time as they may deem proper. Such rules and regulations shall not be contravention of the provisions of the Indian Trust Act, 1882 and Income Tax Act, 1961 in this respect.
13. The Managing Trustee shall have the full power to compromise or compound all actions/suits and proceedings and all differences and demands and to refer any dispute or difference in arbitration's and to adjust, settle and approve all accounts relating to the Trust Funds. The Managing Trustee can sue and be sued on behalf of the Trust.
14. The Trust Fund shall be invested and keep invested and deal with the fund in accordance with the provisions of section 13(1) (d) read with section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
15. To do business only if it is incidental to the attainment of the objectives of the Trust and within the parameters lay down in section 11(4A) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
16. The amendments if any made to the Trust Deed will not be extended to alter the basic character / object of the Trust and no such amendment which may prove to be repugnant to the provision of section 2(15), 11, 12, 13 and 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
17. The Trust is not profit motivated.
18. The Managing Trustee is empowered to execute agreement/ contract with internal and external funding agencies such as Government Agencies, Financial Institutions and other Donor Agencies.
19. The Trustees shall authorize the Managing Trustee to open a savings bank account or accounts and one or more Scheduled Banks or Nationalized Banks or Co - Operative Banks in the name of the Trust.
20. All the incomes, earnings, movable / immovable properties of the trust shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of its aims and object only a set forth in the Memorandum of the trust and no profit, thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus, profits or in any other manner whatsoever to the present or past members of the trust or to any person claiming through any one or more of the present or the past members.
21. No member of the trust shall have any personal claim on any moveable or immovable properties of the

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- trust or make any profits, whatsoever, by virtue of this membership.
22. GENERALLY to do in all public, charitable purposes for public benefit without any discrimination of Caste, Creed, Color, Gender, Religion, Faith, Race or any Nationality. That in case any of the objects of the Trust are held to be non charitable within the meaning of section 2 (15) of the Indian Trust Act, or any statutory modification (s) thereof, the Trustee (s) shall not carry out such objectives.
 23. To manage the properties, assets and funds of the Trust, from time to time, such regulations (not being inconsistent with this deed) as they may think fit for and necessary for the purposes of such management and control or in connection with the execution of any of the subject herein contained or powers hereby vested in them and may rescind or alter any such regulation.
 24. To accept donations, contributions, grants, subscription in cash or in kind from any person, company, firm, association, organizations, government, non government or semi government agencies, national or foreign funding agencies, family Trust, or corporate bodies for furtherance and achievement of the objectives of the Trust.
 25. To appoint officers and members of staff for the Trust and to prescribe their condition of service.
 26. To raise loans with or without security or to invite donation and financial help.
 27. To receive the honorarium or salary against his/her services or involvement in any of the project or programme run by the Trust, which must be decided by the Board of Trustees and approved by the Chairman / Chairperson.
 28. To authorize person (s) to sign or execute documents on behalf of the Trust.
 29. To grant receipts for aid or donation received.
 30. To grant Special Power of Attorney to represent the Trustees in connection with any legal or other proceedings.
 31. To acquire land or building on the lease or way of purchase.
 32. To sell or give on rent/lease or on hire any immovable or moveable property of the Trust for some certain period (s) on such terms and conditions as the Trustees may think fit and proper from time to time.
 33. To open any type of bank account (s) whether saving account, current account, fixed or otherwise, in the name of the Trust or institution (s) or programme (s) run by the Trust with any scheduled banks (s) or post office (s) and to operate by the authorized signatory or signatories as Board of Trustees shall think fit and proper to authorize any person or persons, unless and until determined otherwise the such bank account(s) shall be opened and operated jointly with signatures of any two members of Board of Trustees. The financial year for the Trust shall be from 1st April to 31st March and the accounts of Trust or institution (s) or programme (s) run by the Trust shall be audited yearly by the auditors b(s) or chartered accountant or a firm of chartered accountants to be appointed by the Board of Trustees and the fee for auditor(s), if paid, shall be a part of outgoing amounts from the Trust Funds.
 34. To give guarantee of the assets and property of the Trust, including the bank guarantee on behalf of the Trust to corporate bodies, persons, firms, institutions, as Trustees may decide from time to time. The Trustees shall not be personally liable for such guarantees or the securities.
 35. To gift, lease, and transfer the immovable and moveable properties of the Trust.
 36. To appoint lawyer, pleaders, advocate to file and defend suit or suits filed for and against the Trust and or in the name of the Trust and also file suits for financial and other disputes or dues with different parties and signed executed such application, petition documents for such proceedings and delegate

powers to the officers(s), employee(s), staff(s) and Trustee(s) for such proceedings(s) as required from time to time.

37. To appoint new member or members of Board of Trustees by a resolution and to discharge any of the Trustee, who become bankrupt or acts in any manner prejudicial to the interest or objects of the Trust or is convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude or becomes of unsound mind or is otherwise unfit to continue as Trustee, by resolution passed by simple majority of members present and voting in the meeting of Board of Trustees.
38. To appoint from time to time on such terms and conditions as they may determine a Secretary, Manager, Executive Director, Director(s) and other officer(s) or members(s) of staff for carrying out the activities of the Trust and to remove at any time any such Secretary, Manager, Executive Director, Director(s) and other officer(s) or members(s) of Trust.
39. After defraying all necessary expenses incurred in the collection or realization of the income from the Trust ten percent (20%) of the balance of the income shall be kept in a reserve fund to be utilized when, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees, there is any emergency and the remaining income may be utilized for the purpose of the Trust.
40. The Trustees shall invest the Trust fund in government securities, saving certificates, fixed deposits or in any other form of investment authorized under provisions of **INDIAN TRUST ACT - 1882** and **INDIAN INCOME TAX ACT, 1961**, as they shall deem expedient.
41. All questions relating to the management of the Trust or the exercise of the powers vested in the Trust shall be decided at a meeting or, if necessary and expedient, by circulation. Every such question shall be decided by a majority of the Trustees present and voting in any meeting of Board of Trustees or by the circulation, as the case may be and any action or decision of such majority shall be as valid as if it was done or made by the all Trustees. The Founder / Chairman shall have a casting vote.
42. In case of occurrence of any vacancy amongst the Trustees because of death, resignation or incapacity of any Trustee or any other cause, a new Trustee may be appointed to fill the Vacancy.
43. All matters not provided for in this Trust deed but necessary for the administration of the Trust or for giving effect to the objectives of the Trust may by resolution(s) made by the Board of Trustees carried by a special majority of two third of total number of the Trustees.

NO PERSON BEING:-

- i) An un-discharged, insolvent or
- ii) Convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude, or
- iii) Of unsound mind
- iv) A minor.

CESSATION OF TRUSTEESHIP:

A Trustee mentioned below shall cease to be the trustee of the Trust if:-

- (a) He resigns;
- (b) He becomes insolvent;
- (c) He is removed by the Founder/Chairman/Managing Trustee, if it is found that the trustee(s) activities are detrimental to the activities or administration or funds of the Trust

SUITS:

The Managing Trustee of the Trust is authorized to sue or to be sued on behalf of the Trust.
